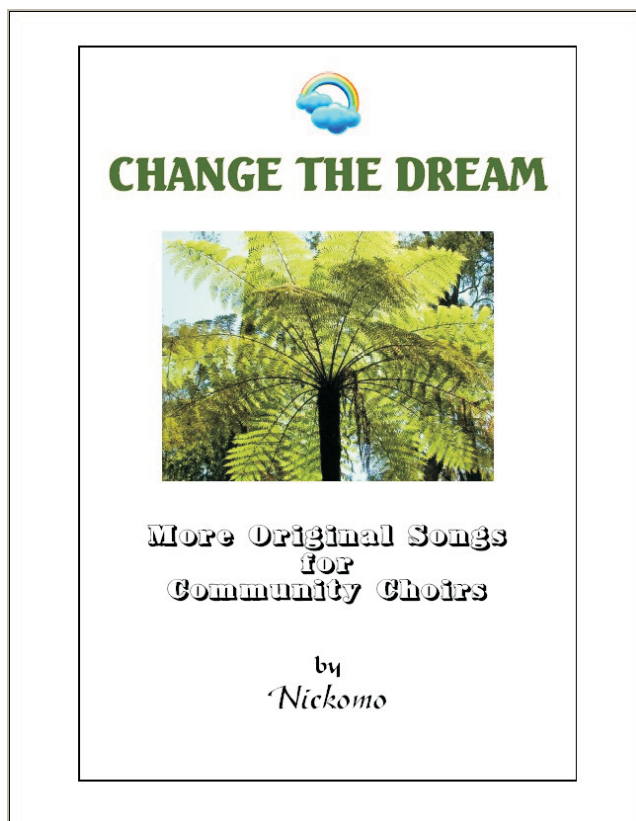

It comes **COMPLETE AS A PACKAGE with a DOUBLE CD** which has full demonstrations of all of the songs and all of the parts.

All the pieces in this collection have been taught successfully to choirs orally, and have received positive feedback from the singers. Most have them have also been performed successfully at concerts.

All the songs are four-part acappella, written for natural-voice ranges, so do not require the ranges imposed by classical choir pieces, and the tenor parts are suitable for lower-voiced women as well as higher-voiced men.

I've tried to make the scores as comprehensive as I can, but the demos on the CDs are a more definitive guide to how they should be sung (but don't sound as good as they do with a choir!).
